

How To Make A Paper Mosquito

Materials :

Construction paper

Pipe cleaners

Color sticky dots

Small hole punch

Scissors

Pencil

Color markers

Stapler

1. Draw the body and wings out on the construction paper.
- 2 .Cut the body and wings out of construction paper
3. Punch two holes in head to attach the proboscis and antennas.

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5. Punch six holes in the body to attach the legs, three on each side .

6. Cut three pieces of pipe cleaner two and a half inches long . Twist the three pieces together at one end . This will be the antenna and proboscis.

7. Draw on and color the body and wing.

8. Place the sticky colored dots on the head to make the eyes.

9. Insert the pipe cleaners that was cut and

stand up with out falling over.

You have now made a paper mosquito!!!

twisted to gather in the two holes on the head. Put the pipe cleaner pass the last hole with enough pipe cleaner to bend back to the front of the head. this will keep it in the holes so it will not fall out.

11. The three holes on the body put a pipe cleaner from one side to the other in the three holes. This will be the legs. After you put a pipe cleaner through the first set of holes twist the pipe cleaner to gather to hold the legs in place and to keep them from moving. Put the other two pipe cleaners through the holes doing them the same way.

12. Use a stapler to attach the wings to the body.

13. Adjust the legs so the mosquito will
