

Childhood Lead Poisoning Screening Map

Nassau County

Lead-based paint in older housing is the most significant source of lead exposure for children. This map displays shaded areas that exceed the national average for pre-1960 or pre-1970 housing. Children ages 1 and 2 living in the shaded areas should be screened. Older children living in these areas who were not screened by age 2 should also be screened.

Directions:

1. Ask the parent for the zip code of the physical address where they live
2. If the zip code is on the list below, ask the parent to point to where they live on the county map
3. If they live in one of the green shaded areas, screen the child
4. If they do not live in one of the green shaded areas, continue the assessment process using the verbal risk assessment questionnaire

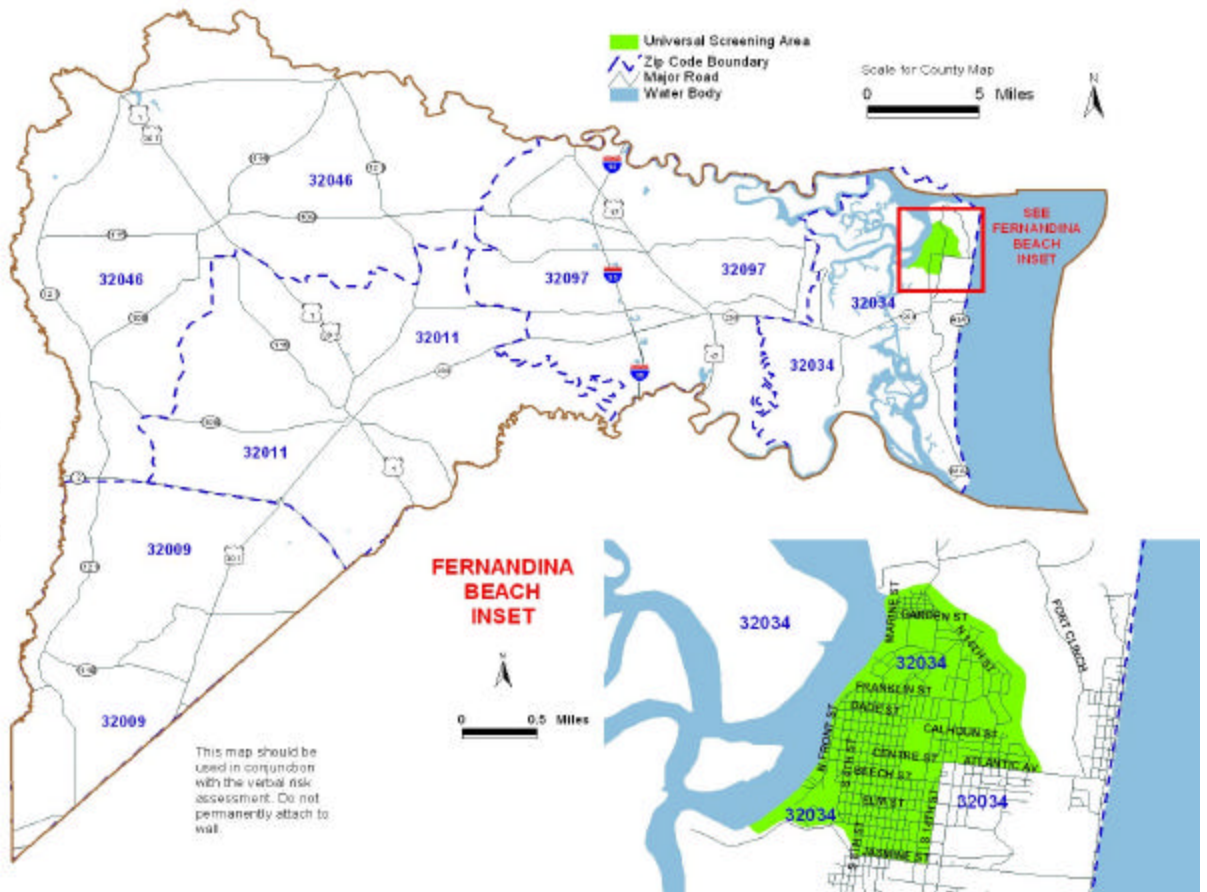
