We are in the process of summarizing community survey results. By the end of May, the analyses of the survey results will be completed and shared with the community leaders of East Jacksonville.

Concisely summarize this month's activities.:

- Neighborhood residents are trying to stop illegal dumping in East Jacksonville. The Environmental Health Sanitary Nuisance Program identified the owner of the property with illegal dumping and is working with him on a clean-up process.
- The survey identified two residents in need of special services. Follow up was conducted that included connecting these individuals to community & health department's resources that can provide assistance.
- Three applications have been submitted for the inclusion of historically relevant East Jacksonville sites to the National Register of Historical Places. We are awaiting Tallahassee's feedback.
- We are in process of obtaining the most current utility GIS data for the GIS component of our PACE project. Available resources to link gathered GIS environmental & utility data into a user-friendly retrieval system are being explored. The goal is to provide easy to read reports for potential investors regarding opportunities in East Jacksonville.
